Main goals and responsibilities

- Develop and implement transportation strategies to meet operational requirements while minimizing costs.

- Work closely with the inventory management team to maintain optimal stock levels and prevent overstock or stockouts, minimize shrinkage, damage, ensure proper storage and rotation, and verify proper packaging and handling procedures.
- Collaborate with procurement to improve transportation processes and enhance overall efficiency with suppliers, or directly with 3rd party warehouses.
- Cooperate with all Marlink warehouses to optimize the flow of goods.
- Develop, implement, and maintain documentation for policies, processes, and procedures in the 3rd party and freight management area to ensure consistent practices and maintain efficiencies and economies of scale; ensure documentation is up-to-date and easy to access.
